- **SMC:** State misdemeanor citation issued.
- **JSA:** Juvenile student arrest made in accordance with applicable law.
- **CBRO:** Incident administratively cleared by the reporting officer.
- **PD/DA:** Prosecuting authority declined to pursue charges.
- **PRV:** Prosecution could not proceed due to the victim's decision not to participate.
- **Active:** Incident remains under review, investigation, or pending administrative or judicial action.
- **Inactive:** Incident has concluded and no further action is anticipated.
